Statement of Acceptance

In response to your request to carry out an inspection at the aforementioned address we may find or become aware of parts or all of the said inspected installation that does not comply with the requirements of the Electricity Act 1945 and the Electricity (Licensing) Regulations 1991.

To be more specific we wish to draw your attention to Regulation 50A and 62 of the Electricity Licensing Regulations 1991 which state:

Licence holder not to cause or permit unsafe wiring or equipment to be connected to electrical installation

50A. A person who holds a licence who causes or permits any wiring or equipment that is in an unsafe condition to be connected, or to remain connected, to an electrical installation or a supply of electricity commits an offence.

[Regulation 50A inserted in Gazette 6 September 1996 p4416.]

Defects to be reported

62. (1) Subject to subregulation (2), where it appears to an electrical worker that there is a defect in any electrical installation or electrical equipment that renders the electrical installation or electrical equipment unsafe, the electrical worker shall immediately report the matter to the owner or operator of the installation, to the relevant supply authority and to the Director.

(2) If –

(a) the electrical worker is carrying out electrical work on the unsafe electrical installation or electrical equipment on behalf of his or her employer; and

(b) the employer holds an electrical contractor's licence or in-house electrical installing work licence,

the electrical worker shall report the matter to the employer who shall then comply with subregulation (1) as if that subregulation referred to the employer and not to the electrical worker.
